

How to pay tax

Paying by cash or EFTPOS at Westpac

When your clients make payments at a Westpac branch or Smart ATM, they'll now need to have a barcode to ensure the payment goes to the right place.

Barcodes are usually printed on Inland Revenue returns, statements or letters.

You can pay online through your bank. Use your IRD number as the reference and G00121023235 as your particular code.

You can take this payment slip into Westpac to make a cash or Eftpos payment

EXAMPLE

IRD TAXX13906 297 3G00 121023235



Barcodes can also be generated on our website, which can be printed, or shown on a mobile device.

To generate a barcode go to ird.govt.nz/barcode

You will need to enter

- your IRD number
- The tax amount you are paying
- Tax Type (select from a drop down list)
- Period you are paying for
